A blend of Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc, lovely aromatic fruit and a crisp finish.	
Australia, Barossa Valley - Rolf Binder Selection Barossa Valley Chardonnay 2011	\$110
A fresh, fruity style with minimal oak. Apricot and peach nose with a lovely creamy palate.	
France, Rhone Valley - Perrin Reserve Blanc 2010	\$125
A bouquet of honeysuckle and wet stones, medium bodied, fresh and outgoing.	
Australia, Victoria - Cooralook Chardonnay 2009	\$120
A cool climate style from Strathbogie, luscious ripe fruit is supported by a mineral backbone.	
Australia, Yarra Valley - Innocent Bystander Chardonnay 2010	\$130
Aromas of lemon sorbet, dried fruit and white peach, ripe fruit on the palate with a touch of steely acidity.	
France, Herault - Magellan Grenache Roussane 2010	\$130
A bouquet of apricots, vanilla and spice, has a somewhat decadent character with smoke and melon flavours.	
New Zealand, Marlborough - Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010	\$130
Showing just a touch of oak from the barrel fermented component, passion fruit and citrus characters.	
France, Madiran - Bouscasse Blanc Pacherenc du Vic Bilh Sec 2007	\$130
Floral nose shows additional complexity from lees contact, dried fruit notes on the palate.	
South Africa, Stellenbosch - Mulderbosch Sauvignon Blanc 2009	\$135
Complex aromas of citrus, gooseberry and cut grass, lively and intense on the palate with a long finish.	
Italy, Veneto - Tamellini Soave 2010	\$140
A very grown-up Soave, this is all about elegance, restraint and poise.	
South Africa, Stellenbosch - Mulderbosch Chardonnay 2008	\$145
Pear, citrus and almond aromas, primary fruit flavours on the palate with touch of vanilla from the oak.	
Italy, Tuscany - Fattoria le Pupille Poggio Argentato 2009	\$150
Roseblossom and citrus characters on the nose, dry and refreshing on the palate with a mineral streak.	
New Zealand, Marlborough - Churton Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2008	\$150
Passion fruit, mango and a subtle mineral note, fine acidity and good length on the finish.	
New Zealand, Martinborough - Ata Rangi Sauvignon Blanc 2010	\$160
Ripe fruit and fresh herbal aromas, zesty and balanced on the palate, the herbs following through.	
France, Burgundy - Verget Bourgogne Grand Elevage 2006	\$190
A distinctly superior Bourgogne Blanc, a trace of oak, a hint of minerality, persistent finish.	
France, Burgundy - Verget Macon Vergisson La Roche 2007	\$190
A touch of wood adds to ripe yellow fruit aromas, these follow through to the palate, punchy finish.	
New Zealand, Martinborough - Ata Rangi Chardonnay Petrie 2008	\$195
Ripe peaches and freshly baked almond custard croissant aromas, citrus, minerals and spicy oak.	
Oregon, Salem - Cristom Estate Viognier 2009	\$198
Mineral, peach, apricot, and floral notes with intense, creamy-textured, spicy character.	
France, Burgundy - Verget Pouilly Fuisse Terroirs de Vergisson 2009	\$198
White fruits, freshly sliced lemon and a hint of wet stone with concentrated and textured flavours.	
France, Burgundy - Verget Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons 2009	\$198
Acacia, spice and earthy nose leads to rich and round flavours with a long and complex finish.	
France, Burgundy - Deux Montille Bourgogne Blanc 2007	\$198
Lemon and straw nose merges into pure and intense flavours with a persistent finish.	
France, Loire Valley - Domaine Roches Neuves Saumur Blanc L'Insolite 2008	\$198
Aromas of flowers and spices, the palate is full of ripe pears and green apple character.	
Australia, Mornington Peninsula - Yabby Lake Vineyard Chardonnay 2006	\$220
One of the stars of the Mornington Peninsula, this is one of Australia's best cool climate chardonnays.	
France, Loire Valley - Alphonse Mellot Sancerre La Moussiere Blanc 2008	\$240
An historic house producing classic terroir driven wines. Firm and long on the palate with mineral touches.	
France, Burgundy - Verget Saint Veran "Chataigniers" 2006	\$250
Wood is evident but is supported by ripe aromas of exotic fruits, round supple flavours with mineral notes.

Very pure Merlot character, no oak, spicy smoky, with a great richness and smooth tannins.	
France, Rhone Valley - La Vieille Ferme Lasira Rouge 2007	\$108
Classic southern red, ripe red fruits, herbs & spice, firm finish with chewy tannins.	
Australia, Barossa Valley - Rolf Binder Selection Barossa Valley Shiraz 2009	\$110
Forward aromas of ripe black fruits, full, round and supple on the palate.	
Australia, Clare Valley - Kilikanoon The Lackey Shiraz 2008	\$115
Classic Australian Shiraz: cedar, plum, and blueberry nose. The palate has sweet berry fruits and chocolate.	
Australia, Victoria - Cooralook Shiraz 2007	\$120
Black fruits with hints of moist earth and spice, full and rich on the palate with supple tannins.

A classic Loire Cabernet Franc, alluring aromas, poised and elegant on the palate with a long crisp finish.	
France, Languedoc-Rousillon - Mas de Daumas Gassac Pont de Gassac Rouge 2010	\$145
Showing even more concentration and complexity than usual, spice and black fruits with an earthy note.	
France, Rhone Valley - Perrin Rasteau L'Andeol 2007	\$150
Aromas of red fruits, the palate carries notes of chocolate, combines substance and elegance.	
Italy, Tuscany - Altesino Rosso di Altesino 2008	\$160
Notes of dark fruits, earthiness and herbs, medium bodied, good balance and excellent length.	
France, Burgundy - Nicolas Potel Bourgogne Rouge Hautes Cotes de Nuits 2010	\$160
Earthy dark berry fruit nose that carries over to the fresh, energetic and mildly rustic flavours.	
Italy, Tuscany - Mori Chianti 2007	\$180
A traditional style of Chianti, lean and elegant, a very versatile match with a variety of cuisines.	
Australia, Clare Valley - Kilikanoon Killermans Run Cabernet Sauvignon 2007	\$180
Ripe blackcurrant and cigar box aromas, palate combines luscious texture with complex flavours.	
Italy, Piedmont - Bruno Giacosa Dolcetto d'Alba 2009	\$180
Up-front ripe red fruit characters, medium bodied, ideal with simple pasta dishes.	
France, Rhone Valley - Beaucastel Coudoulet de Beaucastel Cotes du Rhone 2003	\$190
A mature example of this wine, shows all the style of this great property at a very affordable price.	
France, Loire Valley - Domaine Roches Neuves Saumur Champigny Terres Chaudes 2007	\$198
Aromas of ripe black fruits with a hint of pepper, dense cassis character on the palate with a mineral hint.	
Oregon, Salem - Cristom Pinot Noir Mt. Jefferson Cuvee 2008	\$230
A spicy, slightly herbaceous bouquet with cherry and cranberry aromas. Medium bodied and savoury.	
New Zealand, Marlborough - Churton Marlborough Pinot Noir 2008	\$230
Aromas of dark chocolate, black cherries, plum and spice. Full flavoured and fine grained tannins and minerals.	
Italy, Tuscany - Piaggia IL Sasso 2007	\$290
Violets, ripe dark fruit and oak aromas, rich and dense on the palate with great length.	
France, Rhone Valley - Roger Sabon Chateauneuf du Pape Les Olivets 2009	\$290
Notes of herbs, liquorice, black cherry and pepper, the fruit is seductive and the finish long.	
California, Sonoma Valley - Martinelli Pinot Noir Bella Vigna 2009	\$298
Powerful ripe fruit, with plums, sweet cherries and macerated strawberries. Supple and long on the palate.	
California, Napa Valley - Fisher Unity Napa Cabernet Sauvignon 2008	\$298
Complex aromas of cassis, blackberry, dark chocolate and oak, well balanced with good acidity and tannin.	
New Zealand, Central Otago - Rippon Pinot Noir 2008	\$320
Bright, elegant cherry fruit aromas. Smooth and elegant with fresh berry fruit and cherry notes.	
France, Languedoc-Rousillon - Mas de Daumas Gassac Rouge 2007	\$350
Black cherry, capsicum, cassis and black olives, gripping tannins on the long, powerful finish.	

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
